As always the Spring term is jam-packed with lots of exciting opportunities and memorable moments and we are excited to get on with the business of learning.

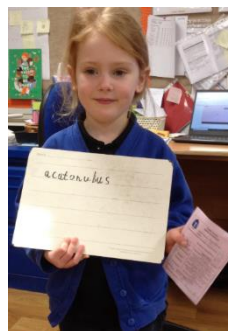


Please take care when parking your car at the start and end of the school day. Do not park on the corner of Front Street as it makes it difficult for children to cross the road safely!
