Face-to-Face Conversations

We believe quick, short messages are best shared in person. You'll find staff available in the playground at drop-off and pick-up times - feel free to approach us then. If you'd like to have a longer conversation, we're happy to arrange a meeting. Simply contact the office on **01673 838330**, and we'll do our best to schedule it within 3-4 working days.

Email

We are one of the few schools that allow direct email communication with teachers. To make the most of this privilege, we kindly ask that emails be used thoughtfully and with respect:

- Use email for non-urgent matters only.
- Keep messages clear and brief. Long, detailed emails can make it harder for us to understand the key points and respond quickly.
- We aim to reply within 3 working days. If we need more time, we'll let you know when to expect a response. Please wait for our reply before sending follow-up emails about the same topic.
- Please understand that staff, including the headteacher, may not respond to emails during the school day. Their focus is on supporting your child and keeping them safe.
- Staff are not expected to reply to emails outside of working hours.

Phone Calls

For urgent or time-sensitive matters, the best way to reach us is by phone. Please call the school office at **01673 838330**.

- Office staff will make sure your message reaches the right teacher as quickly as possible.
- To avoid disrupting lessons, teachers won't be able to take calls during teaching time.
