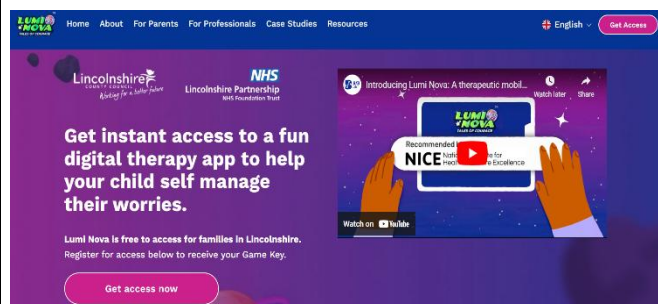

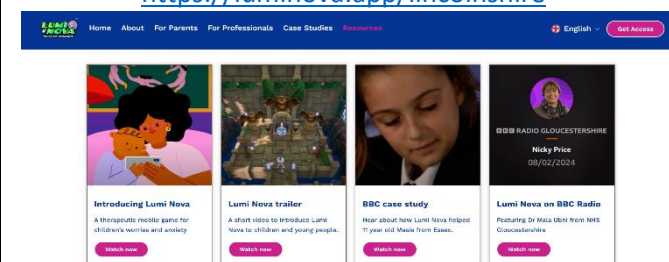

The Year 2s have enjoyed learning about Rocks and Soils over the last few

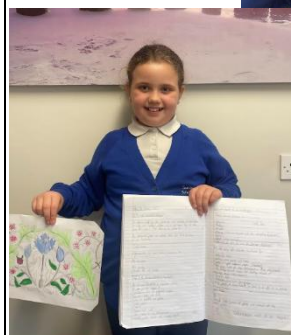
weeks: Harvey has been deepening his learning about minerals and fossils at home. He is very proud of his fossil collection!
