- Think AHEAD to consider consequences and possibilities

By making these thinking processes explicit and giving them clear names, we're helping your children become more conscious of how they think. This awareness empowers them to approach problems methodically, engage in deeper discussions, and develop greater independence in their learning.

From next week, you may notice your child using these terms at home or asking different types of questions. We encourage you to embrace these "moves" in your family conversations - they're simple to learn but offer profound benefits for developing young minds.

We look forward to sharing more about how Thinking Moves is enhancing your child's educational journey throughout the year.

We will also be sharing materials for families to discuss and engage with each week in our Newsletter.
