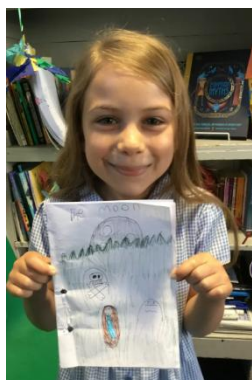


Who is feeling 'PROUD' this week?



Well done to Tilly for winning an amazing award for Hockey this week!

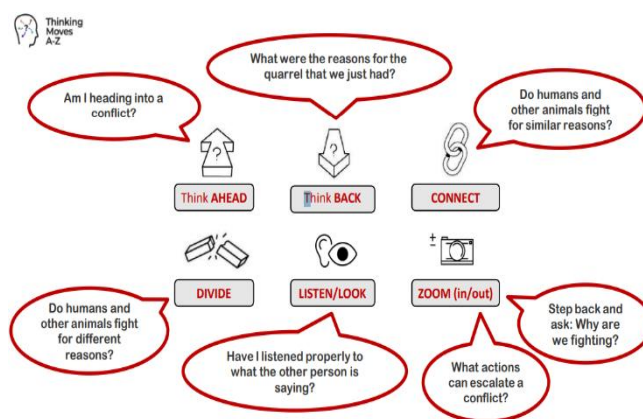
Henry was nominated 'Man-of-the – Match' this week. Fantastic effort, Henry!

Talking to Your Child About Conflict

Conflict is a natural part of life that happens when people have different wants, needs, or ideas. It's those moments when you and a friend both want the same toy, or when children disagree about what game to play.

Key points to share with your child:

- Conflict is normal and happens to everyone
- Disagreements don't mean someone is "bad" or that a friendship is over
- Working through conflicts helps us learn important skills like listening and compromise
- There are healthy ways to express feelings during conflicts (using words, not actions)

The next time your child experiences conflict, help them identify their feelings, listen to the other person's perspective, and work together on a solution that respects everyone involved.
