A special mention must go to our older children in year 3-6, who have been fantastic role models. They have shown great kindness and patience,

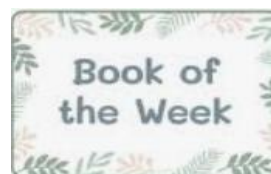


helping the younger ones learn about school life and supporting them with everything from finding their classrooms to joining in with games at playtime.

It really is lovely to see the whole school community working together, with our new starters growing in confidence each day and our older pupils demonstrating such care and responsibility. Moments

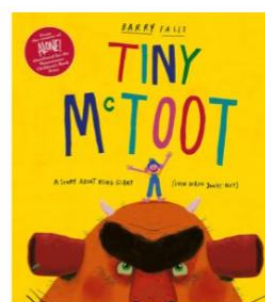


like these truly reflect the nurturing and supportive ethos of Tealby School.

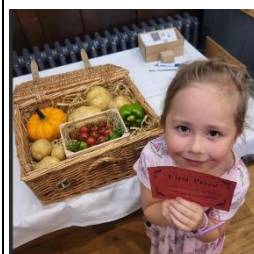


Tiny McToot by Barry Falls is a joyful rhyming picture book about a very small giant who proves that even

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Absence Reporting Procedure

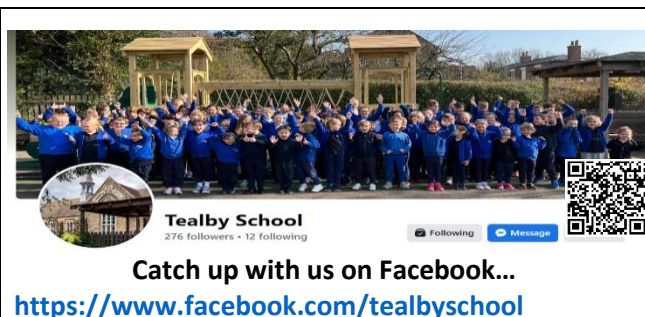
If your child is going to be absent, please **contact the school before 9:00am on 01673 838330** or email enquiries@tealby.lincs.sch.uk to let us know.
