Important Update: Head Injury Procedure



You may have noticed an increase in phone calls home regarding accident slips when an incident involves your child's head. We want to reassure you that this is not due to an increase in accidents, but rather a change in our procedures to ensure every child's safety. Even what appears to be a small bump can sometimes be difficult to assess straight away, as minor head injuries do not always show immediate or obvious signs. For this reason, we are now contacting parents for all incidents involving the head area, even if we believe the contact was very light or may not have occurred at all.

Please be assured this is not an escalation of concern, but a more cautious approach so that parents are always fully informed. We hope this provides peace of mind and reflects our commitment to the wellbeing of all children in our care.

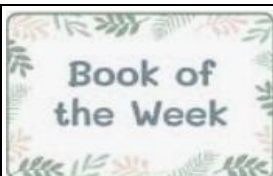
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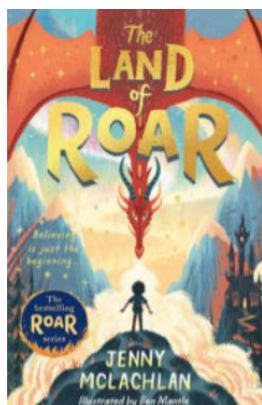


This story for children in KS2 is full of imagination, adventure and excitement and makes for a perfect read-aloud choice for story-time.
