Luke and Noah visited Grimsby Fishing Heritage Centre and were proud to show photos of

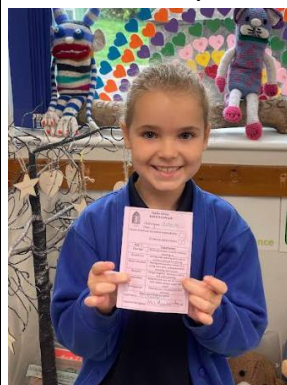
their visit inspired by our Blue Planet project. You have been an inspiration to your class boys, well done!

We are incredibly proud of the children who have earned this recognition this week. These are just a few of our standout stars who have truly lived out our values—well done to each and every one of them!





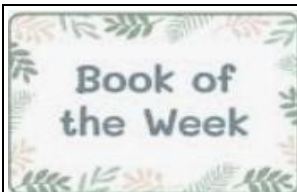
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The Duck Never Blinks Alex Latimer
