Tiny Teachers – Learning Together!

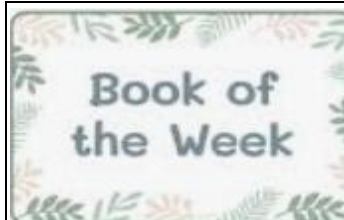
Have you ever wondered what the benefits of mixed-age learning are?

KS1: Can I Build Another Me?

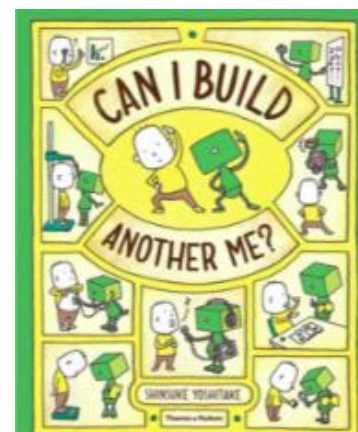

When a young boy decides to build a robot clone of himself, he quickly discovers that copying appearances isn't enough — he must figure out what defines his identity. His journey sparks questions about personality, memories, and the experiences that shape who we are.

Younger readers will delight in imagining what their own robot double might look and act like, while older children can

engage in deeper discussions about individuality, self-awareness, and even the ethics of cloning.
