As part of our commitment to encouraging healthy eating habits, we ask that all children follow our snack guidelines:

Classes 1 & 2: These children are already provided with fresh fruit each day through the national scheme, so they do not need to bring a snack from home.

Classes 3 and 4: Children may bring a snack from home, but it **must be healthy**.

Please ensure that snacks are not sweets, chocolate or crisps.

Good choices include:

Fresh fruit (apples, bananas, grapes, berries, etc.)

Vegetables (carrot sticks, cucumber, cherry tomatoes)

Yoghurt

Cereal bars

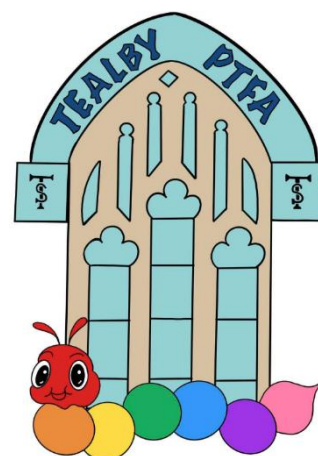
