We have some super swimmers this week: Flynn and Molly have achieved their Level 2 in Swimming which is just brilliant and Jasmine has



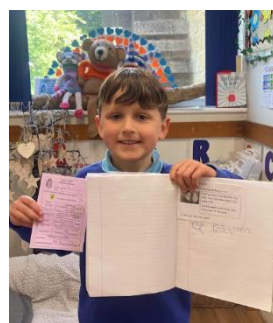
worked her way up to being able to swim a fantastic 50 meters! Well-done to you all – we are so proud of you!
