When is the Colour Dash?

Do children need sponsorship to take part?

Is there a minimum donation amount?

No. Families should not feel under any pressure to fundraise. Any donation, however small, is greatly appreciated and helps support LCH's work with local children and families.

Will children receive a reward?

Yes. All children who take part will receive a reward and enjoy the Colour Dash experience.

Is the coloured powder safe?

Yes. It is made from corn starch and food-grade colouring and is safe for people and the environment. If your child has a corn starch allergy, please inform the school.



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What should my child wear?

Old clothes and shoes that they do not mind getting covered in coloured powder.
