Giuseppe Arcimboldo



- Giuseppe Arcimboldo was a famous Italian painter.
- He is best known for creating paintings which used fruits, vegetables, books, animals and other objects to represent people.
- His artwork was greatly appreciated by many people during his lifetime. It became popular again in the 20th century when **surrealist** artists, such as Salvador Dalí, described him as an influence.

During the reign of Maximilian II, Arcimboldo created a series of paintings called 'Four Seasons' to represent the relationship between people and nature.

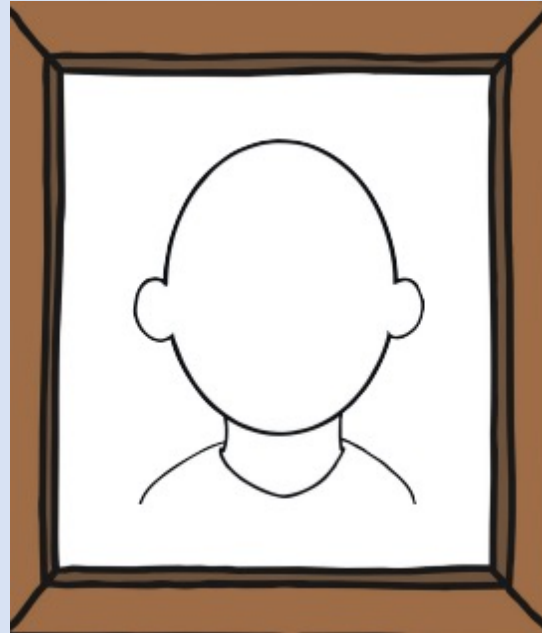
Can you guess which season is which?
