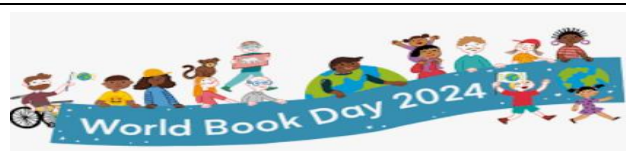
We cannot thank all of you who shopped in TESCOs and cast your votes week on week, we could not have done it without you!
