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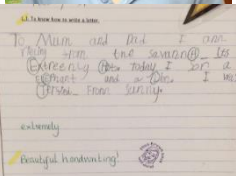
Who is feeling super proud this week...?

Harvey is so proud of his maths learning – he has even been working hard at home!



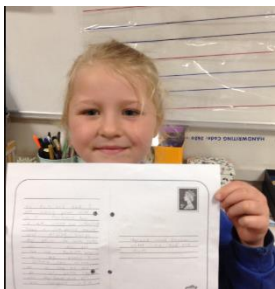
Fred was really proud of his colourful design. It is now brightening up Mrs Humberstone's office.
