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FREE SWIMMING LESSONS



Following a positive response to

the Easter swimming lessons, Market Rasen C of E Primary School and JB's Sports Coaching will be putting on sessions during May half term.

On Thursday 30th and Friday 31st May there will be 30-minute group swimming lessons. Lessons will run from 09:00 to 15:00 on both days.

The programme will provide a fantastic opportunity for all children in the local area to receive swimming lessons free of charge during the half term and will be suitable for primary school children of all ages and swimming ability, from beginner to competent.
