The Village Park: Damage to the Meadow Area

This week I have been contacted by several members of the village about their concerns regarding a fair bit of destruction to the meadow.

It appears that children have pushed through or lain on large sections of the meadow, broken several wooden signs, strewn large pieces of dragged wood in the grass, pulled up some of the cornflowers planted last autumn and thrown baby apples on the ground to go to waste.



The Village Project Team have worked tirelessly over the last four years to help make the park the beautiful place it is and they are now working with the Lincs Trust in an initiative called Next Door Nature and that phrase sums

up why they started the village project in the first place: to try to increase biodiversity in our own back yard.

It is disappointing to see the destruction and lack of respect to such an important part of our community and it saddens me that some of our children may be to blame.

We work so hard in school to teach our children how to care for nature and our environment and I am quite sure that this has not been done with any intent to destroy, but
