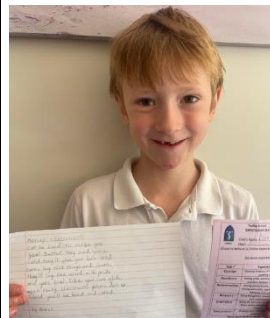
On behalf of the Tealby Primary School staff and Governing Body, I would like to wish you all an enjoyable and safe summer holiday.

Who is feeling proud this week?

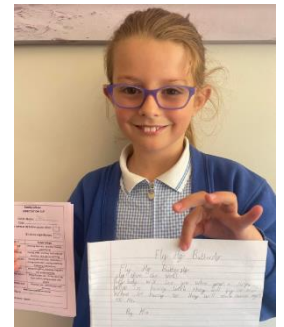
Ivy is proudly sharing her for 'Star-Dancer' trophy from her dance school's festival – look at that beaming smile! Well done, Ivy.
